



REFUND AND CANCELLATION POLICY

MAR Mental Health Therapy

Anger Management Course Refund and Cancellation Policy

The Clinical Anger Management Program is committed to providing high-quality educational services while maintaining fair and consistent enrollment policies.

Registration

Enrollment is confirmed only after registration has been completed and payment arrangements have been approved.

Participant Cancellations

Participants who cancel their registration at least seven (7) calendar days before the course begins may receive a full refund, less any non-refundable processing fees.

Cancellations made fewer than seven (7) calendar days before the course start date are not eligible for a refund but may be applied toward a future course within six (6) months, subject to availability.

Missed Classes

Failure to attend a scheduled class without prior notice does not qualify for a refund.

Participants who miss a session due to illness, family emergency, military duty, or other documented circumstances may request enrollment in a future class when space is available.

Course Cancellation by MAR Mental Health Therapy

If MAR Mental Health Therapy cancels a course due to instructor illness, low enrollment, technical issues, weather, or other unforeseen circumstances, participants may choose either:

- A full refund, or
- Transfer to the next available course without additional cost.

Removal from Class

Participants who are removed from the course because of disruptive behavior, repeated policy violations, intoxication, threats, harassment, or refusal to comply with course expectations are not entitled to a refund.

Certificates

Refunds will not be issued after a Certificate of Completion has been issued.
